Migration and Compatibility

The following instructions show how to migrate from an earlier version to version 6.1.2 of TIBCO ActiveMatrix BusinessWorks Plug-in for Oracle E-Business Suite.



Before starting the migration process, back up the projects that you want to migrate.

Migrating to 6.1.2

You can import projects created in version 6.1.0, 6.1.1 to version 6.1.2. If you want to migrate projects that have been created in a version earlier than version 6.1.0, you must first migrate the project to version 6.1.0 and then perform the procedure to migrate the projects.

Migrating from 6.1.0 or 6.1.1

Since direct upgrade to 6.1.2 is not supported, you must uninstall version 6.1.0, or 6.1.1 and then install 6.1.2 to do the migration. Also before migration have the environment upto date with the latest hotfix.



The EAR files created in 6.1.0 or 6.1.1 are compatible with the 6.1.2 runtime, and they can be deployed directly in 6.1.2 runtime. Also after installing version 6.1.2, you can directly import projects created in version 6.1.0 or 6.1.1 to version 6.1.2.

TIBCO BusinessWorks Container Edition (BWCE) Compatibility from Version 6.1.0 or 6.1.1 to 6.1.2 Design time

To migrate a project from a version 6.1.0 or 6.1.1 to version 6.1.2, import the project created using the version 6.1.0, 6.1.1, or 6.1.2 directly to a BWCE environment having the version 6.1.2.

TIBCO BusinessWorks Container Edition (BWCE) Compatibility from Version 6.1.0 or 6.1.1 to 6.1.2 Run time

EAR Generated in 6.1.0 or 6.1.1 can be directly used in 6.1.2.

Migrating from Version 1.3.0 to Plug-in Version 6.1.0

When migrating projects created in TIBCO ActiveMatrix BusinessWorks Plug-in for Oracle E-Business Suite 1.3.0, which is used with Oracle E-Business Suite 12.1.x to plug-in 6.1.0, the migration procedure depends on the version of Oracle E-Business Suite you use with plug-in 6.1.0.



If an integer type global variable is defined for a long type field of TIBCO ActiveMatrix BusinessWorks Plug-in for Oracle E-Business Suite 1.3.0, after migration, you must create a string type module property and delete the migrated integer module property.

- If you use Oracle E-Business Suite 12.1.x with plug-in 6.1.0, you can migrate projects created in TIBCO ActiveMatrix BusinessWorks Plug-in for Oracle E-Business Suite 1.3.0 to this version by using TIBCO Business Studio™ or by using command lines.

- If you upgrade Oracle E-Business Suite 12.1.x to 12.2.x and use Oracle E-Business Suite 12.2.x with plug-in 6.1.0, follow the steps in [Migration with Oracle E-Business Suite 12.2.x](#) to migrate the projects that were created in plug-in 1.3.0 to plug-in 6.1.0.

Migrating with Oracle E-Business Suite 12.2.x

If you upgrade Oracle E-Business Suite 12.1.x to 12.2.x and use Oracle E-Business Suite 12.2.x with plug-in 6.1.0, complete the following steps to migrate the projects that were created in plug-in 1.3.0 to plug-in 6.1.0:

1. Export the data in the TIB_BW_EBS_LOG table from Oracle E-Business Suite 12.1.x.

See "Exporting Data from Oracle E-Business Suite 12.1.x" in *TIBCO ActiveMatrix BusinessWorks Plug-in for Oracle E-Business Suite User's Guide* for details.

2. Run the `common_all_undo.sql` file that is located in the `TIBCO_HOME/bw/palettes/oracleebs/version_number/config/12.1` directory to revoke the privileges granted to the plug-in user, and to drop the TIB_BW_EBS_LOG table and SQL packages used by plug-in 1.3.0.
3. Upgrade Oracle E-Business Suite 12.1.x to 12.2.x.

When upgrading Oracle E-Business Suite 12.1.x to 12.2.x, if you use the same database instance and encounter issues related to queues, you must drop the queues that were created in Oracle E-Business Suite 12.1.x by using plug-in 1.3.0.

4. Run the `user_upgrade.sql` file that is located in the `TIBCO_HOME/bw/palettes/oracleebs/version_number/config/12.2/upgrade` directory to alter the enabled editions of the plug-in user.
5. Run the `common_all.sql` file that is located in the `TIBCO_HOME/bw/palettes/oracleebs/version_number/config/12.2` directory to re-grant privileges to the plug-in user, and to re-create the TIB_BW_EBS_LOG table and SQL packages used by plug-in 6.1.0.
6. Import the data, which was exported from Oracle E-Business Suite 12.1.x, into Oracle E-Business Suite 12.2.x.

7. Import the projects that were created in TIBCO ActiveMatrix BusinessWorks Plug-in for Oracle E-Business Suite 1.3.0 by using TIBCO Business Studio or by using command lines.

8. Reconfigure the imported projects in the plug-in 6.1.0 environment:
 - a. Reconfigure Oracle E-Business Suite Shared Connection, especially the **Database URL** field.
 - b. Reconfigure the parameters on the **General** tab of the Oracle API activities.

For example, you must click **Search Procedure** to reselect the PROCESS_ITEM procedure. This is because the parameter number of the PROCESS_ITEM procedure in the EGO_ITEM_PUB package changes when you connect to Oracle E-Business Suite 12.2.x. In Oracle E-Business Suite 12.1.x, the parameter number of the PROCESS_ITEM procedure is 74; in Oracle E-Business Suite 12.2.x, the parameter number is 75.

- c. Regenerate and run the SQL scripts for the Oracle Concurrent Program, Custom Concurrent Program, and Oracle Business Event activities.
9. Save the projects.
 10. Create EAR files for the saved projects.
 11. Deploy the EAR files on TIBCO Enterprise Administrator™.

Compatibility with TIBCO BusinessWorks™ Container Edition

Adding the Plug-in to TIBCO BusinessWorks™ Container Edition

To add the plug-in to TIBCO BusinessWorks™ Container Edition, additional steps are required before applying Oracle E-Business Suite applications to TIBCO BusinessWorks Container Edition.

Procedure

1. Open the physical media or download the `TIB_bwpluginoracleebs_version_buildnumber_bwce-runtime.zip` installation package from the TIBCO eDelivery site (<https://edelivery.tibco.com>).



To download the installation package, a user name and password are required. If you do not have a user name and password, contact TIBCO Technical Support.

2. Extract `oracleebs.thirdparty.runtime` folder from the `.zip` file to a temporary folder.
3. Delete the `oracleebs.thirdparty.runtime` folder from the runtime `.zip` file.
4. Place the third-party (name should be `ojbc.jar` and not `ojbc6.jar` for oracle driver) Jars files in the following folder: `oracleebs.thirdparty.runtime/runtime/plugins/com.tibco.bw.palette.oracleebs.thirdparty`.



Alternatively copy the `com.tibco.bw.palette.oracleebs.thirdparty` folder from `BWCEHOME/bwce/palettes/oracleebs/6.1/runtime/oracleebs.thirdparty.runtime/runtime/plugins` folder.

5. Place this `com.tibco.bw.palette.oracleebs.thirdparty` folder in the `resources/addons/jars` folder for docker and/or cloud foundry image/buildpack creation.
6. Add the `.zip` file to TIBCO BusinessWorks Container Edition run time.
 - To add the `.zip` file to TIBCO BusinessWorks Container Edition run time for the Cloud Foundry platform, see *The BusinessWorks Container Edition Buildpack in Developing for Cloud Foundry of TIBCO BusinessWorks Container Edition Application Development*.
 - To add the `.zip` file to TIBCO BusinessWorks Container Edition run time for Docker/Docker based platforms, see "Creating the TIBCO BusinessWorks™ Container Edition Application Docker Image" in "Application Development for Docker" of *TIBCO BusinessWorks™ Container Edition Application Development*.

Key	Summary
AEBS-698	When you provide Apps User Name other than Apps in the OEBS Sharedresource Connection Configuration, you are unable to establish connection for Oracle Business Suite.
AEBS-696	When you clicked the Package Search button for the Oracle E-Business Suite API or custom APIs, the dialog box did not return to the Search option and it did not return any objects.
