The following features have been added in this release of TIBCO[®] Product and Service Catalog (formerly known as TIBCO[®] Fulfillment Catalog).

TIBCO Product and Service Catalog KeyValue repository

A new tab for **KeyValue** is introduced in the Offer and Price Designer UI. This repository establishes a relationship between product-keyvalue, discount-keyvalue, rule-keyvalue, and price-keyvalue. The repository defines a key-value pair. For more information, see the "Adding a KeyValue" section in the *TIBCO Product and Service Catalog Offer and Price Designer User's Guide*.

New relationship attribute for ProductComprisedOf relationship

The Attribute Based Decomposition relationship attribute is added to the ProductComprisedOf relationship of the Product repository. Hence attribute-based decomposition can be defined for each ProductComprisedOf relationship individually and not just on the child level. For more information, see the "Relationship Attributes for ProductComprisedOf Relationship" section in the *TIBCO Product and Service Catalog Product Catalog Guide*.

New relationships for the PlanFragment repository

The CompensatedBy and RedoneBy self relationships have been added to the PlanFragment repository. Modeling of the Compensate and Redo configurations is possible at PlanFragment level. Typical Duration UoM and Maximum Duration UoM

The Typical Duration UoM and the Maximum Duration UoM relationship attributes are added to the MileStone ToMileStone relationship of the MileStone repository. The repository attributes Typcial Duration UoM and Maximum Duration UoM are added to the PLANFRAGMENT repository. The upgrade utility has been enhanced so that you can now perform full export of data from TIBCO Product and Service Catalog 4.0.2 and 4.1.0 to the current version (5.0.0). This migrated data is compatible for import to the enterprise of TIBCO Product and Service Catalog 5.0.0. Publish category records

Issue ID	Summary
AC-3119	The following error occured when accessing the mastercatalog webservice: Code: GEN-7021: IO exception. Additional information: java.io.IOException: Broken pipe, Failed to get output stream.
AC-2740	When you added a characterisitic by entering a value in Action field of the Relationships Attribute tab and clicked Save and Process , the characteristic was added with an Active status even when no action was defined in the Action repository.
AC-2494	For approval tasks of child products, no workflow tasks were created.

AC-3241	Summary: In the Offer and Price Designer, you cannot configure the offer type for a multi-container setup.
	Workaround: Update the fc_opd docker file by adding the following parameters as the ENTRYPOINT parameters:
	• -Dfc.poType=PO,BUNDLE,SERVICE
	• -Dfc.bpoType=BPO,HARDWARE
	You can provide the poType and bpoType as required.
AC-3240	Summary: An error message is displayed during the creation of an offer in the Offer and Price Designer if you add all the field values first and then add the KeyValue record at the end to the offer being created.
	Workaround: Create an offer with the KeyValue first and then edit offer and add other fields. You can also create offer with other fields and then edit the offer with the KeyValue pair.
AC-3230	Summary: The About page has Launched state listed in the Offer status section. The launched state is still to be implemented.
	Workaround: None
AC-3209	Summary: Any record created from the Offer and Price Designer cannot be deleted using the Bulk Delete operation.
	Workaround: None
AC-3205	Summary: If the Offer and Price Designer enterprise had only one offer in the Rejected state, it is not displayed on the Offer List page.
	Workaround: None
AC-3186	Summary: The text TIBCO [®] Product and Service Catalog is cut on the About screen.
	Workaround: Resize the About window.
AC-3178	Summary: Workitems created before migration vanish from the inbox after you migrate from TIBCO [®] Fulfillment Catalog 4.1.0 to TIBCO [®] Product and Service Catalog 5.0.0.
	Workaround: In the inbox, select ALL in the State field.
AC-3175	Summary: When uploading an image for creating a KeyValue, a null pointer error occurs on the Hierarchy Management page.
	Workaround: You can attach the document from the OPD enterprise.

AC-3132	Summary: After you create TIBCO Fulfillment Catalog enterprise solution and try to import data (ZIP file) by using the TIBCO Fulfillment Catalog import data feature, an error occurs inconsistently. An error also occurs if you try to bulk delete the entries.
	Workaround: Reimport the ZIP file using the TIBCO Fulfillment Catalog import data feature.
	For the error that occurs during bulk delete, perform the process for bulk delete again.
AC-3128	Summary: When creating an offer, switching between tabs results in the following error:
	Non-matching for creation tag
	Workaround: Switch to another tab only after the current task is completed.
AC-3126	Summary: During validation of adding the <i>comprised of</i> relationship, the following error message is displayed:
	Cannot specify unrelated records in the same request
	Workaround: None
AC-3124	Summary: Documentation web help is not working for the TIBCO Fulfillment Catalog multicontainer setup.
	Workaround: None
AC-3107	Summary: The following error occurs when you start the TIBCO Fulfillment Catalog:
	[io.undertow.request] (default task-16) UT005023: Exception handling request to /eml/Login: java.lang.NoClassDefFoundError: Could not initialize class com.tibco.mdm.admin.jmx.LoginStatsManager.
	Workaround: Estimate and plan the replication required for TIBCO Fulfillment Catalog pod and update the replicas parameter in fc.json before creating the TIBCO Fulfillment Catalog deployment.
AC-3105	Summary: The following error message is displayed in the TIBCO Fulfillment Catalog startup logs:
	ERROR [org.jboss.as.controller.management-operation] (ServerService Thread Pool 52) WFLYCTL0013: Operation ("add") failed - address: ([
	Workaround: None
AC-3075	Summary: During delta publish, even the records that are not modified are published.
	Workaround: None

AC-2985	Summary: The following error message is displayed in the TIBCO Fulfillment Catalog error logs:
	ERROR com.tibco.mdm.infrastructure.cache.as.CacheSizeUtility - Distributed and near caches allocated memory exceeded specified Memory
	Workaround: None
AC-2898	Summary: When a manufacture date for an offer is entered in the Offer and Price Designer and then published in the TIBCO [®] Product and Service Catalog, the date is displayed in the following format: 2019-07-26T18:30:00.000Z.
	Workaround: None
AC-2879	Summary: Date format is not available when entering a date in TIBCO Fulfillment Catalog.
	Workaround: When entering the date, ensure that you use the mm/dd/yyyy format.
AC-2961	Summary: An error occurs during the importing of an exported .CSV file containing a KeyValue attachment.
	Workaround: None
AC-2852	Summary: Offer and Price Designer users cannot view the status of a deleted offer or rule until it is rejected or approved by the administrator. The administrator cannot see a request for deletion on the Offer and Price Designer user interface.
	Workaround: Log in to TIBCO Fulfillment Catalog as an administrator and approve or reject the rule or offer deletion.
AC-2842	Summary: Offers or rules deleted from the Offer and Price Designer are not deleted from TIBCO Fulfillment Catalog. They appear in the Pending Approval state.
	Workaround: None
AC-2679	Summary: On the Characteristic , Segment , or Sales Channel tabs, modified offers are not updated with new or modified links.
	Workaround: After making changes on the Characteristic , Segment , or Sales Channel tabs, navigate to another tab before clicking Submit . This workaround force updates the new and modified links.
AC-2601	Summary: The unit of measurement cannot be viewed when the Rules Editor page is opened in read-only mode.
	Workaround: None
AC-2354	Summary: When validating a record on the home page, the following error message is displayed: Cannot specify unrelated records in the same request
	Workaround: None

Issue ID	Summary
AC-2211	Summary: When you search for products, the autocomplete mechanism only displays up to 20 entries, even if more products match the query.
	Workaround: None
AC-2042	Summary: In the Internet Explorer browser, the Catalog Use drop-down list is not displayed.
	Workaround: Use other supported browsers.
AC-2027	Summary: Event log pagination does not work in PostgreSQL.
	Workaround: None
AC-1874	Summary: Template instances are not displayed correctly in any of the supported browsers.
	Workaround: Increase the screen resolution or reduce the tree width on the left to ensure that the action menu appears on a single line.
AC-1857	Summary: Multiple pop-up windows appear when modifying record attributes on the Hierarchy Management page in any browser except Firefox.
	Workaround: Use other supported browsers.
AC-1832	Summary: For PostgreSQL database, an exception is thrown if you add a milestone to a plan fragment using the Hierarchy Management canvas.
	Workaround: None
AC-1815	Summary: For PostgreSQL, TIBCO Fulfillment Catalog installation changes file permissions on PostgreSQL data directory resulting in failure when starting the server.
	Workaround: Change the file permission manually before starting the server.
AC-1811	Summary: Delta Export does not fetch any data if the Characteristic relationship is added.
	Workaround: Add the relation in the forward way instead of the reverse way.
AC-1737	Summary: In TIBCO Fulfillment Catalog, the display name of an enterprise can contain multi-byte characters. This causes an issue when the same names are used as Enterprise Internal Name in applications such as TIBCO [®] MDM where only ASCII formats are supported.
	Workaround: Do not use multi-byte characters for the display name of the enterprise.
AC-1684	Summary: Removing milestones and adding SLA to planfragment from Hierarchy Management gives pf_relationship.
	Workaround: Delete the PLANFRAGMENT record and re-create with SLA data only.

Issue ID	Summary
AC-1647	Summary: You cannot upload images on the Hierarchy Management and TIBCO MDM pages.
	Workaround: Save and then process the record. Once the record is processed, the image/document link starts working. The image/document link still works even if the record has been changed.
AC-1221	Summary: Applying invalid project tag name in a relationship results in a validation error for its reverse relationship.
	Workaround: None
AC-369	Summary: On the Graphical Edit page, you can modify the record by using <access mode="view_record">.</access>
	Workaround: None
