#### Information for users on TIBCO Collaborative Information Manager 8.2.x and TIBCO MDM Add-on for Global Data Synchronization 1.2.1

If you are currently on TIBCO Collaborative Information Manager 8.2.x and TIBCO GDSN 1.2.1:

- 1. Install TIBCO MDM 9.0.0.
- 2. Run the latest applicable hotfix for TIBCO MDM 9.0.0 HF-002 onwards.
- 3. Run the TIBCO MDM Add-On for Global Data Synchronization Migration wizard from the Configurator.
- Specify the upgrade details like previous and new installation locations of the MQ\_HOME directory and click **Next**.
- 5. Specify the existing and new common values (MQ\_COMMON\_DIR) and configuration (ConfigValues.xml) information and click Next.
- 6. Select **Complete Migration** and click **Next**.
- 7. Specify the database details like database name, user name, and password.
- 8. Click Finish.
- 9. Repeat steps 3 to 5 and select the Rules migration option.
- 10. A warning is displayed. Click **OK** to ignore the warning. However, if you have modified the orglist.txt and orglist-processSelection.txt files, click Finish.
- 11. Install the latest version of TIBCO MDM Add-on For Global Data Synchronization 3.0.
- 12. Run the Add-On Plug-in Installer from the Configurator.
- 13. To run the Add-On Plug-in Installer from the Configurator, Select **Tools** > Add-On Plug-in Installer.
- 14. Select Plugin for Global Data Synchronization Add-on 3.0.1 from the Plug-in Type drop-down list.

- 15. Select **Migration to Existing Version**.
  - Select 3.0.1 from To Version.
  - Select 1.2 from From Version.
- Click Next.
- 17. Select the **Complete** option.
- 18. Click Next.
- 19. Specify the MQ\_COMMON\_DIR path and click Next.
- 20. Specify the database details like database name, user name, and password.
- 21. Click Finish.

#### Information for users on TIBCO Collaborative Information Manager 8.2.x and TIBCO MDM Add-on for Global Data Synchronization 3.0.0

If you are currently on TIBCO Collaborative Information Manager 8.2.x and TIBCO GDSN 3.0.0:

- 4. Specify the upgrade details like previous and new installation locations of the MQ\_HOME directory and click Next.
- 5. Specify the existing and new common values (MQ\_COMMON\_DIR) and configuration (ConfigValues.xml) information and click Next.
- 6. Select **Complete Migration** and click **Next**.
- 7. Specify the database details like database name, user name, and password.
- Click Finish.
- 9. Repeat steps 3 to 5 and select the Rules migration option.
- 10. A warning is displayed. Click **OK** to ignore the warning. However, if you have modified the orglist.txt and orglist-processSelection.txt files, click Finish.
- 11. Install the latest version of TIBCO MDM Add-on For Global Data Synchronization 3.0.

- 12. Copy the following jars:
  - From GDSN\_HOME\lib\plugins to MQ\_HOME\lib\plugins
  - From GDSN\_HOME lib\props to MQ\_HOME\lib\props
- 13. Specify the MQ\_COMMON\_DIR path and click Next.
- 14. Specify the database details like database name, user name, and password.
- 15. Click Finish.

#### Information for users on TIBCO MDM 8.3.x and **TIBCO MDM Add-on for Global Data Synchronization 1.2.1**

If you are currently on TIBCO MDM 8.3.x:

- 1. Install TIBCO MDM 9.0.0.
- 2. Migrate from TIBCO MDM 8.3.x to TIBCO MDM 9.0.0. Follow the instructions in the TIBCO MDM 9.0.0 release notes to migrate.
- 3. Run the latest applicable hotfix for TIBCO MDM 9.0.0 HF-002 onwards.
- 4. Install the latest version of TIBCO MDM Add-on For Global Data Synchronization 3.0.1.
- 5. Run the Add-On Plug-in Installer from the Configurator.
- 6. To run the Add-On Plug-in Installer from the Configurator, Select **Tools** > Add-On Plug-in Installer.
- 7. Select Plugin for Global Data Synchronization Add-on 3.0.1 from the Plug-in Type drop-down list.
- 8. Select **Migration to Existing Version**.
  - Select **3.0.1** from **To Version**.
  - Select **1.2** from **From Version**.
- 9. Click **Next**.
- 10. Select the **Complete** option.
- 11. Click Next.
- 12. Specify the MQ\_COMMON\_DIR path and click Next.
- 13. Specify the database details like database name, user name, and password.
- 14. Click Finish.

#### Information for users on TIBCO MDM 8.3.x and TIBCO MDM Add-on for Global Data Synchronization 3.0.0

If you are currently on TIBCO MDM 8.3.x:

- 1. Install TIBCO MDM 9.0.0.
- 2. Migrate from TIBCO MDM 8.3.x to TIBCO MDM 9.0.0. Follow the instructions in the TIBCO MDM 9.0.0 release notes to migrate.
- 3. Run the latest applicable hotfix for TIBCO MDM 9.0.0 HF-002 onwards.

- 4. Install the latest version of TIBCO MDM Add-on For Global Data Synchronization 3.0.1.
- 5. Copy the following jars:
  - From GDSN\_HOME\lib\plugins to MQ\_HOME\lib\plugins
  - From GDSN\_HOME lib\props to MQ\_HOME\lib\props
- 6. Specify the MQ\_COMMON\_DIR path and click Next.
- 7. Specify the database details like database name, user name, and password.
- 8. Click **Finish**.
