	1. After installation, take a backup of <fsi_home>/tomcat/conf/server.xml file and open <fsi_home>/tomcat/conf/server.xml file in any text editor.</fsi_home></fsi_home>
	2. Find the <connector> tag of `protocol="AJP/1.3" `. Provide a suitable port number as required.</connector>
	3. Find the <connector> tag of `protocol="HTTP/1.1 `. Provide a suitable port number as required.</connector>
	4. Find the <server> tag of `shutdown="SHUTDOWN"`. Provide a suitable port number as required.</server>
	5. If SSL is configured, then find the <connector> tag of `sslProtocol="TLS" `. Provide a suitable port number as required.</connector>
	6. Save the <fsi_home>/tomcat/conf/server.xml file.</fsi_home>
INV-482	<b>Summary</b> : When running a search from the item search pane, the trash icon for the items feature is visible when you search by clicking <b>Search</b> . However, the <b>Trash</b> icon does not appear if you press ENTER to run the search.
	Workaround: None
INV-404	<b>Summary</b> : Login name does not support right single quotation mark or the French single quote (U+2019).
