## **New Features**

The following features have been added in this release of TIBCO MDM.

### TIBCO MDM as a Container: Additional Cloud Platform Support

TIBCO MDM (Cluster) containers are now also supported on the following cloud platforms:

- Microsoft Azure Kubernetes Service (AKS)
- Amazon EKS
- Google Cloud Platform
- Red Hat OpenShift Container Platform

TIBCO MDM also provides readme.txt files with instructions to run sample application on Kubernetes by using the sample Kubernetes object specification (.yaml) files for these cloud platforms. You can also use Helm charts to deploy TIBCO MDM to run on Kubernetes.

### **Graphical Editor**

The Graphical Editor feature has been introduced to display the visual tree representation of record hierarchy. The new Graphical Editor action is added on the **Browse and Search** and **Text Search** tool bar to invoke Graphical Editor for records.

### **Automatic Hierarchy**

The Hierarchy Management feature has been extended to automatically create hierarchies based on the selected attribute values in the records. You can use the automatic hierarchy feature for large volumes of data, where manually creating hierarchy and linking records is an unmanageable task.

Custom matching using query builder platform of TIBCO® Patterns - Search

You can use the query builder platform tool of TIBCO Patterns - Search to search for records. The Query Builder Platform (a Java based tool) that eases the process of designing, testing, and administering TIBCO Patterns - Search record matching queries. For configuration, see Custom Matching Using Query Builder Platform of TIBCO Patterns - Search.

After detecting duplicate records, the source and target records are passed through the Surviving Record Selection activity for merging process. The selection of target record is based on the auto-selection rule. For information about the auto-selection rules and record auto-selection configuration file, see *TIBCO MDM Customization*. For information about parameters of the Surviving Record Selection activity, see SurvivingRecordSelection Activity.

### Right to Be Forgotten

The Right to Be Forgotten scheduler job has been added in the Configurator to permanently delete records from the repository based on the attribute name and its value. For information, see Right to Be Forgotten

#### Predicate Indexes

The predicate indexes feature of TIBCO Patterns - Search has been added to TIBCO MDM to improve the performance when huge data is uploaded in TIBCO MDM.

### **Deduplication Tool**

A new deduplication tool is introduced to deduplicate and group millions of customer (parent) records. By using this tool, you can locate duplicate records before coming to TIBCO MDM. Deduplication and grouping process identifies groups of duplicate records within a dataset. Grouping process categorizes known duplicates into groups. For information, see Deduplication Tool.

### **Performance Improvements**

The following features have been improved for better performance:

- Apache Ignite with raw mode: Reduces memory size requirements
- Search query: Retrieves confirmed records from the GOLDENCOPY table
- Use of multithreaded indexing when indexing records in TIBCO Patterns Search: Processes index entities asynchronously, and then each thread processes records in batches
- Mass update using REST services: Supports a large number of record updates
- Import records by using the Direct Load option: Updates index definition for better direct load performance

The following functionality and features have been changed in this release of TIBCO MDM.

## **Changes to the Configurator web server**

The Apache Tomcat web server was used for hosting the Configurator web application. It is now replaced with Eclipse Jetty. The related folder and file references have been updated the TIBCO MDM *Installation and Configuration* and TIBCO MDM *System Administration*.

The following issues have been fixed in this release of TIBCO MDM.

## Closed Issues

CIM-31062	The removed reverse relationship between the records were added back into the record bundle when a new modify request was initiated for the record.
CIM-31026	Error occurred on UI when an optional attribute value was set to NULL in workitem.
CIM-30442	Loading of repository attributes failed due to the ORDER BY clause contained in the SQL query on the large data sets.
CIM-30423	For the input file (used with -uf option), you could only specify the path relative to the user home. You can now specify the path relative to MQ_HOME and the absolute path.
	The file contained a list of PRODUCTKEYID, PRODUCTID, and a combination of PRODUCTID and PRODUCTIDEXT of the records to be purged. You can now also specify an SQL query, which retrieves the list of PRODUCTKEYID.
CIM-30267	After upgrading Google Chrome from version 80 to 83.0, you could not create or modify records.
CIM-30265	If a record was modified more than once (in the following cases), the Processlog ID did not maintain direct proportion to the product version.

	When TIBCO MDM was configured in a cluster
CIM-30260	A performance issue occurred in the record bundle loading after you modified the root record and clicked the <b>Save &amp; Process</b> button.
CIM-30217	Multiple email notifications were configured to reassign work items to the selected users and roles. However, email notifications were not sent.
CIM-30202	After running the Modify Record activity recurrently (without any update) from TIBCO ActiveMatrix BusinessWorks™ Plug-in for MDM, a new version of the parent record was created instead of returning the "Data Unchanged" message.

CIM-30163	The precedence management rule did not work on the merge record operations through the Merge Record web service and Manual Merge from UI.
CIM-29946	When modifying a record by using the Record Modify web service, a null pointer exception occurred in the response. The empty RelationshipData information in the web service request caused this issue.
CIM-29839	When running the Record Add REST service with "process": "false" and "validate": "true", the record was saved (as Unconfirmed) even though one or more errors were reported in the REST response.
CIM-29789	The UnZipFile activity usually takes FileName as an input parameter; however, when the file was provided as input, an exception occurred. If you specify the file as an input, change the value of the type attribute from "String" to "Document".

CIM-29711	In TIBCO MDM Studio, after deploying the output map with the cross repository relationship, the relationship output map was not created with the parent output map.
CIM-29681	When reimporting data from one enterprise to another (by using the Data Transfer option), an error was returned in the event log because of the lengthy attribute name in the input map.
CIM-29576	After migrating from TIBCO MDM $8.3.0\ {\rm toTIBCO}\ {\rm MDM}\ 9.2.0,$ an exception occurred when modifying any record in any repository .
CIM-29634	TIBCO MDM 9.2.0 supports Apache Tomcat® 9.0.31 for containerization and onpremises.
CIM-29567	When running the Add Record and Modify Record activities using TIBCO ActiveMatrix BusinessWorks™ Plug-in for MDM 6.4.0, an error occurred if the timestamp format on the Add User page was set to YYYY-MM-DD HH-mm-ss.S z, YYYY-MM-DD HH-mm-ss.S AM/PM, or YYYY-MM-DD HH-mm-ss.S AM/PM z.

CIM-29557 On the Browse and Search page, when you selected a value in the **Repository** dropdown list, the page stopped responding. As a result, a list of values matching the criteria was not displayed in the **Repository** drop-down list. CIM-29555 On the Merge Record page, you could not copy the cell values to the clipboard. A fix has been made to support the record bundle caching with Apache Ignite. #### CIM-29530

When the NamedVersionPrefix parameter was used in the EvaluateSubset activity, the records that were corrected (without version change) after the last evaluation were not included in the output record list.

### CIM-29514

When adding a duplicate record (the same record with different product ID and extension) through the Add Record web service in the synchronous mode (after configuring the data quality for a repository), a null pointer exception occurred.

### CIM-29504

When running the Add Record and Modify Record activities from TIBCO ActiveMatrix BusinessWorks™ Plug-in for MDM 6.4.0, an error occurred if the timestamp format on the Add User page was set to the following formats:

- YYYY-MM-DD HH-mm-ss.S Z
- YYYY-MM-DD HH-mm-ss.S AM/PM
- YYYY-MM-DD HH-mm-ss.S AM/PM z

CIM-29384	When cleaning data history for a specific timestamp range with the purge command, the command removed all history until the current timestamp even after no history records were found for the specified timestamp range.
CIM-29343	Relationship tree performance issue was observed after migration.
CIM-29325 CIM-29326	After a record was moved to the next user in the workflow for approval, if the next user modified the record by adding another attachment or a file to the multivalue file type attribute, the attribute displayed the following error: Failure while copying File.
CIM-29349 CIM-29540	A rulebase was defined to hide record attributes in a child repository based on the RECORD_ACTION context variable.  However, the hide validation feature did not work in the View Record mode and the attributes were visible.
CIM-29348 CIM-29539	A fix has been made to correctly compute precedence during import, if the previous import source weight was less than the latest import source weight.
CIM-29320 CIM-29538	If you imported a file that did not contain a password configuration, an error was displayed after clicking the user name on the User Accounts page.  However, the status of the event erroneously indicated that the import was successful.
CIM-29308	You could not uninstall TIBCO MDM by using the Silent installer file.
CIM-29294	The Save Record activity failed during workflow execution.
CIM-29293	In Internet Explorer 11, after clicking the <b>Show All Errors</b> link on the Record Add or Record Modify page, an error was displayed.
CIM-29292	After exporting metadata by using the <b>Export Metadata (Wizard)</b> option for business process, an incorrect directory structure was created in the export ZIP file.

	The issue occurred only on the migration environment.
CIM-29291	After modifying a record from the work item page and clicking <b>Save</b> , a new version of the record was created instead of redirecting to the Record Modify page.
CIM-29287	If a user had full permissions on a work item and ALL was selected in the <b>Repository</b> and <b>User</b> drop-down lists, and if the user approved the work item, the following error was displayed after submitting the work item: GEN-7012: Incorrect number of parameters specified. Usually indicates program error. Additional information: Mismatch in the number of values supplied and no. of OrderBy or Unique Cols defined for the scroller.  However, the work item was processed correctly and the workflow was completed.
CIM-29286	A rulebase was defined for the Quantity relationship attribute to verify whether the attribute was defined or not. However, after defining the relationship attribute on the Modify Record page, the Record has errors message was displayed for related records on the work item page.
CIM-29285	When a related record was added to the root record by using the <b>Create Related Record</b> option, the related record was added outside of the relationship structure.
CIM-29284	A record search using reverse relationship criteria did not return any records.
CIM-29283	After logging in to TIBCO MDM, the work item list was not refreshed in the Inbox.
CIM-29282	By using the Retrieve Records by ID and IDEXT REST service, you could not retrieve the CONFIRMED parent record with the CONFIRMED child record.
	To resolve the issue, a new goldenBundle boolean type query parameter has been added.
	<ul> <li>If you set the value of goldenBundle to true, the response contains details of the parent and child records whose record state was CONFIRMED.</li> </ul>

CIM-29281	When you added a record using the Record Add web service or using the add record palette of TIBCO ActiveMatrix BusinessWorks™ Plug-in for MDM, the value was sometimes not assigned to the relationship attribute of integer type.

CIM-29267	When the workflows were run as in-memory, the record state remained as Unconfirmed on the TIBCO MDM UI.
CIM-29266	The forward relationship and the reverse relationship of the parent or child repositories were returned in the REST Search service response.
CIM-29265	The POST HTTP method did not work for the ModifyRecord and ModifyRelatedRecord REST services.
CIM-29264	The REST services were not supported when TIBCO MDM was configured with the LDAP login module.
CIM-29263	If a multivalue attribute was marked as quick viewable and contained the percent sign (%) in its value, the work item failed to open and displayed an error message.
CIM-29258	Clicking the <b>Show All Errors</b> link on the record UI displayed a blank page instead of showing the validation errors.
CIM-29257	Clicking the <b>Show All Errors</b> link on the record UI displayed a blank page instead of
