These release notes are for the TIBCO Spotfire® for Apple iOS app. They are provided to inform you of new features, known issues, and issues from previous releases that have been closed.

New Features

No new features have been added to version 2.9.2 of the TIBCO Spotfire® for Apple iOS app.

Migration and Compatibility

Version 2.9.2 of Spotfire for Apple iOS is compatible with, and was tested with, the following configurations.

Installation requirements

Category	Requirement
Operating system	iOS 10 and iOS 11
TIBCO® Spotfire software	Connection to a Spotfire® Web Player service, version 7.0.x or higher.  There are no known restrictions on the type of connection (such as VPN) that is used. If the mobile device can connect to the Spotfire Web Player service from the Safari browser (over HTTP/S), the Spotfire for Apple iOS app also should be able to connect. Because the app connects using some dedicated web services, any security appliances or reverse proxies between the services must be configured properly to allow those requests and responses through.

Authentication options

The authentication for the Spotfire environment must be configured for one of the following authentication types.

For Spotfire Server 7.5 and later, use the one following.

- Basic Database¹
- Basic LDAP²
- Kerberos³
- NTLM
- SiteMinder

For Spotfire Server and Spotfire Web Player 7.0 and earlier, use one of the following.

Changes in Functionality

Version 2.9.2 of Spotfire for Apple iOS includes the following changes in functionality.

We have removed support for OpenID web connect (sf-web authentication type).

Closed Issues for Spotfire for Apple iOS app

The table lists closed issues in Spotfire for Apple iOS app.

Key	Summary
SPAD-2059	Support for the sf-web authentication type has been removed.
SPAD-2060	Attempting to stop the closing of an analysis by tapping outside the confirmation popover did not work properly: The analysis would close. This issue has been fixed.
SPAD-2061	The app could close unexpectedly when it attempted to load an analysis in the Analysis view. This issue has been resolved.
SPAD-2065	The color palette or font size popovers were not dismissed when you tapped another control. This problem has been fixed.
SPAD-2071	If you quickly switched between libraries, the app could close unexpectedly. This issue has been fixed.
SPAD-2081	Previously, if your analysis contained web page panel, the contents of the web page panel would open in a web browser, and it could not be dismissed. This problem has been fixed.

Known Issues

Version 2.9.2 of TIBCO Spotfire® for Apple iOS contains no known issues.
