TIBCO Spotfire® for iPad Release Notes

These release notes are for Spotfire Deployment Kit for Apple iPad and related features in the TIBCO Spotfire[®] for Apple iPad app, February 2015. They are provided to inform you of new features, known issues, and issues from previous releases that have been closed.

Spotfire Deployment Kit for Apple iPad provides the tools and resources to develop a customized app for displaying Spotfire analytics to mobile devices.

General Improvements

This release of Spotfire Deployment Kit for Apple iPad focuses on general improvements for custom configurations, including login, app startup, and display.

New Features

The following new features have been added to version 2.6.0 of TIBCO Spotfire® Deployment Kit for Apple iPad and the TIBCO Spotfire® for Apple iPad app.

Pre-configured server connections

The Spotfire Deployment Kit for Apple iPad now includes a section in the MyConfiguration.plist file that supports pre-configuring server connections in the custom app. The developer can specify the server URL and title of the connection and specify an SSO URL, which can be a full or partial URL for a custom web page for login. See the TIBCO Spotfire® Deployment Kit for Apple iPad guide for more information.

Incrementing the app version number with each new release can provide important controls over this configuration option. If you provide a custom server connection in MyConfiguration.plist, the specified connection replaces any server connections from previous app versions. To make sure your custom server connection is updated correctly, you must update the app version number for each new version.

Google Analytics tracking

This version of the Spotfire for Apple iPad app adds application usage tracking via Google Analytics so patterns of use in the app can be tracked for quality and marketing purposes. (No personal information is collected during the app usage tracking process.) See the *TIBCO Spotfire* Deployment *Kit for Apple iPad guide* for more information.

Splash screen display duration

The Spotfire Deployment Kit for Apple iPad now includes a section in the MyConfiguration.plist file called SplashScreenDuration, which is set to 0 by default. This value can be set to any number of seconds, including fractional seconds. Even at 0, the splash screen is shown at Apple's default duration, which is a fraction of a second. There are several new customizable splash screen images that the Spotfire for Apple iPad app uses to display a splash screen with, depending on the orientation of the device. See the TIBCO Spotfire® Deployment Kit for Apple iPad for more information

Custom login option

Spotfire for Apple iPad now has the option to open a custom login page Url whenever that URL is encountered via redirection when the user requests library or analysis content. A new Setting option "SSO URL" is available in the iOS Settings app entry for the Analytics app. With this setting, you can specify a relative or absolute URL for your enterprise single sign-on or custom login page. The default value for this option is /ssologin. The app detects any URLs that contain this value for any library

server added to the app, and then opens a special popover web page view for that URL to allow login to your system. The setting value accepts standard regex-style search syntax.

Spotfire for Apple iPad also offers customizable connection icons to indicate when the server is selected, and a customizable login support message to provide guidance to the user who has problems logging in to the service.

Spotfire Cloud

Spotfire for Apple iPad now supports sign-in with an existing TIBCO Spotfire® Cloud account

Search function support

Spotfire for Apple iPad now has search function support for TIBCO Spotfire® Server Library (version 6.0 and higher)

New icon

There is a fresh new look to the Spotfire for Apple iPad app icon.

Version 2.6.0 of TIBCO Spotfire[®] Deployment Kit for Apple iPad contains no removed or deprecated features.

Closed Issues

These issues have been fixed in the Spotfire Deployment Kit for Apple iPad.

Key	Summary
513	Log files generated by the app using the Settings option Log Application Activity are now marked with a flag that prevents them from being backed up in iTunes and/or iCloud.

These issues have been fixed in version 2.6.0 of the Spotfire for Apple iPad app.

Key	Summary
513	Log files are no longer backed up in iTunes and/or iCloud.
1201	In some cases, the modification date of the analysis did not display properly. This issue has been fixed.
1287	Occasionally the analysis opened in the app would appear as seen in the Spotfire Web Player. This issue has been resolved.

Key	Summary
1308	The server display name field was obscured by the keyboard when you edited library server connections in landscape orientation.
1452	The app might crash when you added a new library server, or edited an existing one, and did not provide the username and password in the dialog. This issue has been corrected, and now you are prompted for the required information.
1497	When a new user launched the app, the app would prompt the user to allow notifications. This issue has been fixed.
